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MIX RATIO

Resin (A) : Hardener (B)

1 : 1 by volume.

For example 100ml Resin

to 100ml Hardener

1.2 : 1 by weight.

For example 120ml Resin

to 100ml Hardener

Mix well for 3 -5 minutes

WORK TIME

2.5 Hours at a room

temperature of 25°C

CURE TIME

Touch Dry - 5 - 6 Hours

Full Cure - 24 - 48 Hours

Hardness - Shore D 85

Heat Resistance - 90°C

STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry location away from sunlight and high humidity.

Shelf Life - 6 months at 25°C

Always seal the lids after use.

Apex Resin CurePro is a premium product that delivers both performance and reliability for a wide range of applications. Whether used for art, jewellery or decorative surfaces, its superior durability, extended work time, and self-levelling properties ensure professional results every time.

Mix part A and part B thoroughly, but not vigorously to avoid trapping air for 3 - 5 minutes scraping the sides and bottom of the container.

Any bubbles created by hand mixing can be easily popped by passing warm air over the surface of the resin with a heat gun on slow speed settings. Work at a distance of approx 10cm above your artwork. DO NOT use a flame to remove bubbles, as alcohol is flammable.

Protect the piece from dust accumulation whilst it cures.



SAFETY

Apex Resin® Quantum is non toxic and safe for home use when used as directed. As with all Resins, it is important that you read the safety precautions and SDS sheet carefully before use and contact us if you have any questions.

- Always wear nitrile gloves.
- Work in a well ventilated room. If this isn't possible we recommend a respirator is worn.
- Wear a respirator when sanding or polishing resin.
- Protect eyes. In case of contact, wash with plenty of water for more than 15 minutes and seek medical advice.
- Avoid skin contact, if contact occurs, wash well with soap and water
- Allow the resin to fully cure before handling
- Avoid contact with clothes and furniture
- If resin is poured onto any unwanted areas please wipe immediately with a clean, dry cloth using acetone or a similar solvent
- Do not eat, drink or smoke while working
- If swallowed, seek medical advice immediately if you feel unwell
- If alcohol inks have been used, do not use a torch or naked flame as alcohol is flammable.
- Keep out of reach of children
